

Terms and Conditions for Abstract Submission

1. Submission Guidelines

- Abstracts must be submitted for review via the designated online submission portal by the specified deadline.
- Abstracts must be written in English and conform to the specified formatting guidelines provided on the submission guidelines accessible via the conference website.

2. Abstract Author Consent

- The submitter of the abstract must ensure that all co-authors have consented to the submission and are aware of the terms and conditions.
- The submitter must provide accurate and up-to-date contact information for all authors.

3. Review and Selection

- Submitted abstracts will undergo a peer-review process.
- The conference review panel reserves the right to accept or reject abstracts based on relevance, quality, and adherence to the conference theme.
- Decisions of the review panel are final and not subject to appeal.

4. Presentation and Publication

- Accepted abstracts will be scheduled for presentation at the conference as either oral or poster presentations, as determined by the scientific committee.
- Abstracts accepted for presentation will be included in the conference program and may be published in conference materials or proceedings, unless otherwise specified by the author.
- The committee may decide to allocate the submitted abstract to a different topic than the topic for which it was originally submitted.

5. Copyright

- By submitting an abstract, the authors grant the conference organisers the right to publish the abstract in conference-related materials.
- Authors retain copyright of their abstracts and presentations.

6. Registration

- Presenting authors of accepted abstracts must register for the conference by the registration deadline (30 January 2025) to confirm participation.
- Failure to register by the deadline may result in the exclusion of the abstract from the program.

7. Changes and Withdrawals

- Requests to withdraw or make changes to an abstract after submission must be sent in writing to the conference organisers.
- Withdrawals within 6 weeks of the conference date cannot be guaranteed removal from physical/printed collateral such as (but not limited to) the program and abstract book.
- Changes may be accommodated at the discretion of the scientific committee, depending on the stage of the review process.

8. Liability

- The conference organisers are not liable for any costs, damages, or liabilities incurred by authors related to the submission, review, or presentation of their abstracts.

9. Errors

- MJDF cannot be held responsible for any typing, spelling, or language errors in the submitted abstract(s).

10. Acceptance of Terms

- Submission of an abstract implies acceptance of these terms and conditions.
