



# NSW Rural Generalist Medical Training Program


- A supported pathway for junior doctors wishing to pursue a career as a rural general practitioner able to provide:
  - primary care within a community general practice setting; and
  - advanced services and/or procedural skills within a rural hospital
- Community general practice is the main provider of primary health care in NSW
- The Health Education and Training Institute works with stakeholders to coordinate and deliver a structured training program linking career aspirations with rural training and employment opportunities



### NSW – Four Year Program

Training Program is up to four (4) years in duration and integrated with general practice training

Figure 2: NSW RURAL GENERALIST (MEDICAL) TRAINING PROGRAM PATHWAY




## NSW – 6 Pathways
