Educational and architectural ideas:

This project is a new Kindergarten to Year 12 school located in Alkimos; a new coastal housing estate on the northern edge of Perth.

The first stage of buildings provide accommodation for young children and have been designed to provide a flexible, playful and enriching environment.

To build community we have designed the buildings to facilitate gatherings in the central gallery spaces and provided generous entry areas featuring a café servery and a built-in wood fired pizza oven to be used by parents and children alike.

The buildings have been designed with alcoves and furnishable corners to facilitate colonisation by students and teachers.

A continuum of space without internal doors between classrooms allows children to utilise the whole building in a dynamic manner with loose furniture used to create flexible and readily changeable settings.

Northshore CGS highly values independence and responsibility in and for all stakeholders. Providing flexible work spaces allows students and teachers to choose the best spaces to get their work done, whether this be in a collaborative setting or a space to hide away and focus on the job at hand independently.

Each room was designed and has delivered the desired impact on our learning. It is great to see the full range of options being utilised daily.




