Terms & Conditions for CEC Scholarships

The below outlines the Terms and Conditions for all scholarships administered by the Clean Energy Council (CEC).

You must read these Terms and Conditions in full before submitting any application. By applying it is understood that you have read and agree to comply with these Terms and Conditions.

The personal information we collect from you is necessary for us to assess your application for any scholarship offered. It's important that all information marked as 'required' is provided within your application to ensure it is valid.

Scholarships are only open to those living and working in Australia.

All applicants' details are held with the CEC for the purposes of assessing and shortlisting the most suitable candidates. All details of shortlisted candidate applications will be provided to the selection review committee for the purposes only of preparing for the interview stage.

Basic demographic details of all applicants may be shared with scholarship funding partners for the purposes of showing successful outcomes of the scholarships and/or securing future funding.

By submitting your application, you agree to be available during the nominated interview timeframe should you be shortlisted. Every effort will be made to give applicants plenty of notice, however if you are not available during this stage the CEC reserves the right to not progress your application.

By applying all recipients must be willing to participate in promotion of the scholarship, including but not limited to providing a headshot, bio and testimonial for use on social media and other promotional materials.

Applicants can receive a total of one scholarship. You cannot apply for more than one CEC scholarship in each calendar year. In addition to this, previous CEC scholarship recipients cannot apply for another scholarship within two years of receiving any other scholarship from the CEC.

Terms & Conditions specific to Chloe Munro Scholarship for Transformational Leadership

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship you must:

- Be currently employed in a field relating to renewable energy, energy management (including energy efficiency and demand response) or carbon abatement
- Have a clear idea of how completing this scholarship will support your professional development
- Identify as a woman

- Possess a minimum of 12 months experience in one of the above fields
- Have a demonstrated commitment to the clean energy industry
- Have demonstrated leadership potential and a desire to lead others

Or, for the Executive Ready Course

- Have a minimum of 3 years' leadership experience in one of the above fields
- Have a demonstrated commitment to being a leader in the clean energy industry
- Have a desire to accelerate your career towards senior and executive level performance

All applications must be received, with the required supporting documentation, before the application portal closes either at **midnight on Sunday on Sept 10**th **2023**, **or earlier if there are a large number of applications**. Any applications received after the portal closes will not be eligible.

If successful, candidates must be willing for the headshots and testimonial provided on the contact page of the application portal to be used on social media and other promotional materials.

All recipients must enrol within the nominated course by 30 June 2024. This refers only to enrolment and does not refer to completion of the course. All enrolments must be confirmed by Leadership Australia. If you do not enrol, you risk forfeiting your course enrolment. All course options are final and are not transferable to another individual.
