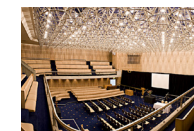

## The Venue



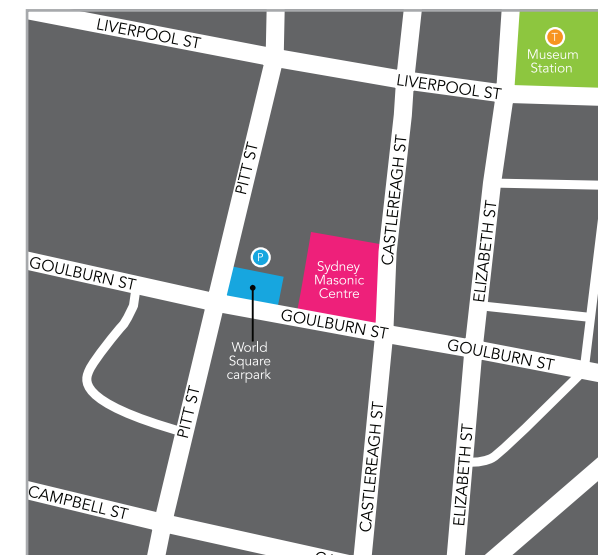
