Keynote Title: Putting Embedded Intervention into Routine Practice in ECI: Implementation Strategies to Support Adoption through Sustainability

Supporting the adoption, implementation, and sustainability of evidence-informed practices or innovations in authentic contexts has been a persistent challenge across many fields, including early childhood intervention. In this keynote, I will describe a multi-year initiative using an implementation science framework and associated strategies to guide the adoption, implementation, and sustainability of embedded intervention practices in a statewide early intervention system. Lessons learned about facilitative implementation strategies and those helpful in overcoming challenges will be shared.
