死 SA Water		The Adelaide Desalination Plant (ADP) is a 100 gigalitre per annum desalination plant serving the southern Adelaide area with 2 separate process plants each with a capacity of 150 megalitre production per day.		
		The ADP site is also SA Water's largest renewable energy generator with 68,656 solar panels or 24.75 megawatts and 6.2 megawatts of battery energy storage system (BESS) installed.
