Bryan (*Ngāti Māhanga/Tainui*) is the first Māori Paediatric Cardiologist at Starship Children's Hospital and is the clinical lead for paediatric cardiac transplantation and heart failure. His interests include cardiomyopathies, pulmonary hypertension, and inherited heart conditions as part of the Cardiac Inherited Diseases Group (CIDG).
