


Gross Pollutant Traps – Gravity Separators



- Extended flowpath
- Convoluted path
- ♥ Slow the velocity of flow
- ₢ Allow separation
- ₢ Treatment flow rate
- ♥ Volume
- ₢ Temperature

Gross Pollutant Traps – Hydrodynamic Separators






Direct screening (devices that incorporate screens in various orientations to the flow and which are not self cleansing)

Self Cleaning Trash Screen for Irrigation Water - Delta, Colorado



Continuous deflective separation (devices that combine a vortex/hydrodynamic separation with a non-blocking screening system)












In Reverse Direction of flow - large open area
