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Schools Commonality

Required a Champion teacher driving initiative to be successful 1 School leaders with no teacher support showed decrease in participation by students I Schools with highest student enrolment lower participation rates

After Effects

Inner city school reported increase in walkers after Move It finished | Semi rural school had behavioural issues when students returned to using the bus

Engagement

Face to face with school communities is more successful than any other form of contact

Timing

Term 4 clashed with senior student school camps reducing push from leaders

KEY: Create a competitive environment

Leading schools had in-house competitions between classes

Enviro Schools

Stop plastic giveaways and replace with 'Active Rewards' to fun places (skate park, pump track)

Motivators

Schools: Desire to reduce congestion at school entrances Students: Win collateral
