MELLINGTON CABLE CAR

is recognised as an engineering achievement of outstanding heritage significance by the Institution of Professional Engineers New Zealand.

Opened in 1902 as a combined cable training and funicular, the Cable Car is one of the best-known works of prominent engineer James Fulton (1854-1928). Although it has been extensively modernised, it still uses the original tunnels and formation. Residents and Victoria University of Wellington students use it daily and it is a popular tourist attraction.

Added to IPENZ's Engineering Heritage Register in 2012. Plaque unveiled 2015.
