The benefit of communities

- Provide a safe environment for our people to share knowledge and create genuine connection.
- Connect the organisation on a broad scale, rather than being limited to one team or group.
- Break traditional hierarchies to connect different levels in the organisation, and give a holistic perspective.
- Form a shared understanding of who is doing what, both within Waka Kotahi and with our partners/stakeholders.
- Create opportunities for micro-learning within the organisation.
- Provide a channel for the business to communicate their experts – internal or external.
- Create a space where our people can invest in relationships and access different ways of thinking/working.
- Provide an opportunity for folks to share their pilots/early thinking.
- Increase visibility of innovation, leverage lessons learned, and connect work.





What is a "Community"?

Communities of Practice

- Communities of Practice are defined by a shared area of expertise or specialty.
- Community members are practitioners and committed to learning/growing through active participation. All are welcome within the community, and communities are not limited by formal structure/hierarchy.
- The goal of the community is to create connections, share tacit and explicit knowledge, encourage thought diversity, and grow expertise/proficiency.
- Community members will apply their learnings as part of their practice.
- Communities can be role-based or expertise-based.
