NZMC

- Cosmetic medicine is defined as the branch of medicine concerned with improving appearance and therefore quality of life of patients
- The NZMC defines cosmetic procedure as Category 1- surgical- restricted to surgeons, dermatologists and ophthalmologists

Category 2- non-surgical- restricted to members of NZSCM, surgeons, Dermatologists and registered Medical Practitioners practicing under oversight Endorsed by NZMC and RNZCGP

Required standard to practice cosmetic medicine independently in Aotearoa



Provide postgraduate training pathway for Vocationally trained Medial doctors in Cosmetic medicine

Provide ongoing training, supervision and professional accreditation

- 2-year Diploma
- Comprises- 7 practical weekend workshops/yr, prescribed reading, NZSCM annual scientific meeting, peer group meeting, presentation, OSCE and MCQ exam



- Modalities covered- Botulinum toxin, dermal filler, Radiofrequency ablation, Laser and IPL hair, tatoo, vascular and pigmented lesion removal, photorejuvenation, dermal remodeling treatments
- Maintain a logbook- 50 BT/ 50DF/ 50 other
- Audit project
- Practice Visit



NZSCM

- The diploma is the pathway to membership of NZSCM
- Maintain annual CPD
- Valid resus certification
- 1 audit every 3 years
- Triennial practice Visit quality assurance programme for reaccreditation




