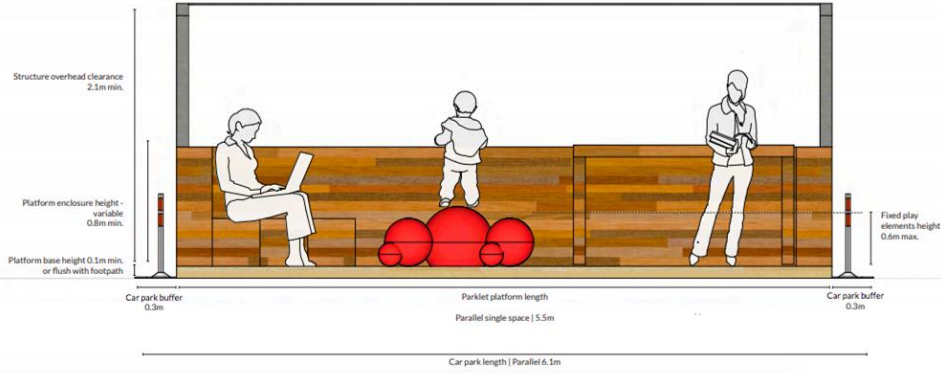

Despite being a blustery and breezy Ponsonby Market Day, I was able to be on the strip enjoying the vibe and entertainment

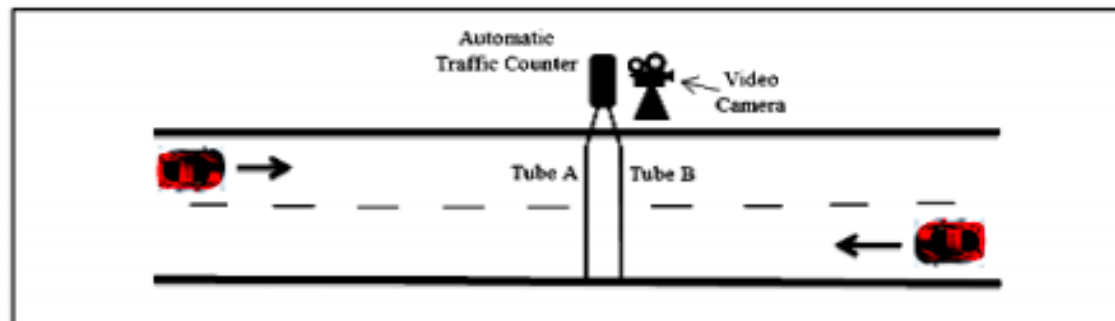

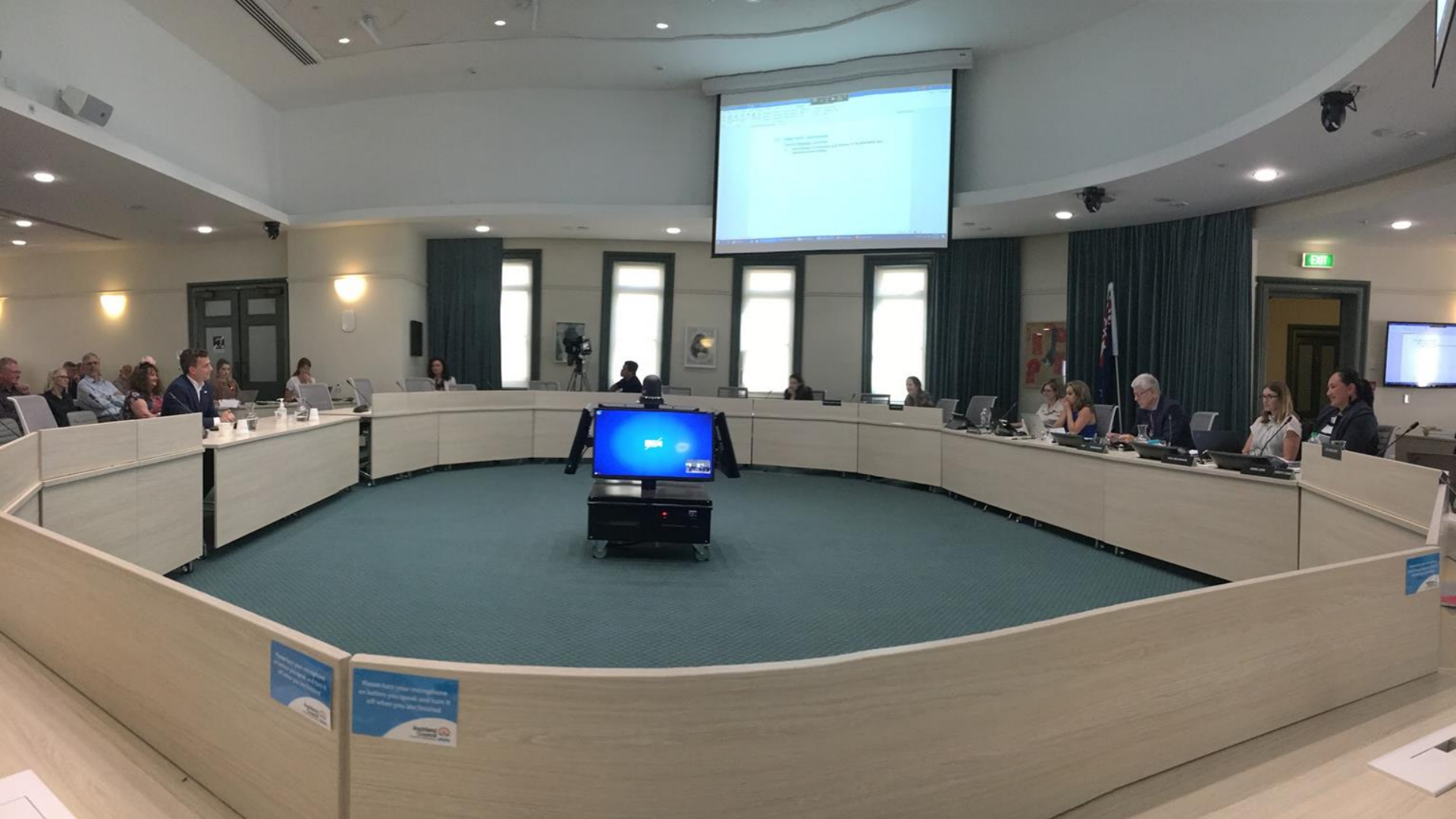




**Figure 3.** Layout of on-pavement equipment and video camera







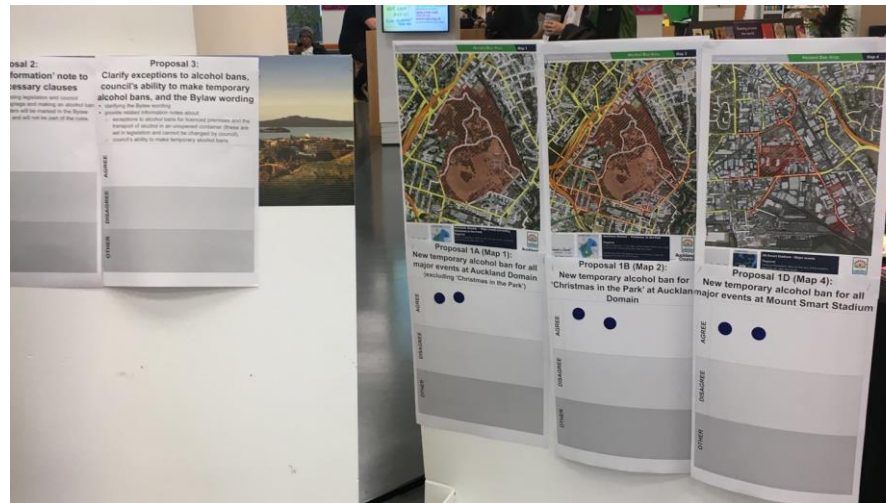
