# The Peninsula Connection Project is part of Dunedin's strategy to connect communities






## The existing road geometry did not provide for safe walking and cycling







# Our objective was to connect communities and provide alternative means of transport




Typical Section



#### Reclaimed up to 8m into the harbour

- Rocky seabed habitat was relocated
- 105,000m2 of geotextile
- 160,000m3 of bulk fill





### 10km of hand placed seawall

- 40,000m2 of sea wall
- 1,000,000 rocks
- All hand placed


