Payments

Full payment must be received prior to the Conference. Once registration is received, a confirmation email and tax invoice will be issued. Any accounts must be paid in full 14 days from the invoice date or 10 business days before the Conference start date, whichever comes first. The Conference organisers reserve the right without notification to cancel outstanding accounts any time after 14 days from the date of the tax invoice being sent. If payment is not received prior to the Conference, access will be granted only after full payment is made via credit card.

Payment can be made via credit card or electronic funds transfer. For electronic funds transfer the appropriate banking details can be found on your invoice. Please note if your registration is made less than two weeks prior to the Conference, the only payment option available is credit card.

Cancellations

All cancellations must be advised in writing to the Conference Organisers.

We understand that circumstances can change. At any point prior to the event you are welcome to contact us in writing to nominate a substitute delegate at no extra charge.

Cancellations received before 20 September 2024 will receive a refund of registration fees less an administration charge of \$150.00. Cancellations after this date will not be refunded.
