


Activation Add-on








Exhibition Room

ACE 2023 Partner and Exhibitor Booking Terms and Conditions

All partners and exhibitors must agree to the following terms and conditions for sponsoring and/or exhibiting at the 2023 AuSAE Conference and Exhibition (referred to as ACE), organised by the Australasian Society of Association Executives AuSAE (referred to as the organisers).

1. Confirmation of exhibition and/or sponsorship can only be made upon receipt of a completed 'ACE Booking Form', agreeing to the Terms and Conditions outlined and a deposit.

2. If you have chosen an option that is already sold out, you will be contacted upon receipt of your 'ACE Booking Form' and deposit to arrange an alternate option acceptable to your organisation. Once a floor plan is available, we will assign Pods on a first in first served basis.

3. The pod space is provided for use by a single exhibitor or partner and cannot be resold, shared or otherwise packaged, bundled or consolidated with other exhibitors, partners or suppliers without the prior written consent of AuSAE. This does not prohibit a company that ordinarily sells products from exhibiting that product as part of promoting its business but does prohibit intentional group buying or on-selling of AuSAE exhibition offers.

4. Cancellation of sponsorship or exhibition space must be received in writing on or before 30 September 2023. Cancellations received before 30 September 2023 will receive a refund of any monies received, less a \$1000.00 administrative fee. For cancellations received after 1 October 2023, AuSAE reserves the right to retain all monies unless a replacement sponsor can be found. While every reasonable precaution is taken, the organisers expressly decline responsibility for any loss or damage which may befall the person or property of the exhibitor from any cause whatsoever.

5. While every reasonable precaution is taken, the organisers expressly decline any loss or damage which may befall the person or property of the partner from any cause whatsoever. ACE Exhibitors and Partners are advised to take out adequate cover, especially Public Liability Insurance. Public Liability Insurance is not included in the pod or partnership cost. Exhibitors may be asked to provide a certificate of cover from their insurer or purchase public liability coverage from the organisers.

6. Exhibitors, Partners and their families are not eligible to enter any prize draws during ACE. Any Major Prize Draws are open only to those from not-for-profit organisations not exhibiting. Should a prize be won by an exhibitor, sponsor or a family member of an exhibitor or partner, it will be re-drawn.

7. If the organisers cannot hold the 2023 AuSAE Conference and Exhibition (ACE) due to acts of God, government or other events beyond our control, partners and exhibitors will receive a proportionate refund of any monies available after fixed costs have been met. The organisers are not responsible for any further costs incurred by partners and exhibitors in connection with the event.

8. Partners and exhibitors are responsible for providing artwork, logos and text as relevant by the due dates. The organisers take no responsibility for publishing artwork, logos or text received after the due date or in an incorrect format.

9. Partners and exhibitors will receive an information pack containing due dates, requirements and other information after the 'ACE Booking Form' and payment have been received.

10. Respective sponsors will receive a copy of the conference delegate list with permission for one pre and one post-conference communication (includes emails for participants who opt-in and are subject to privacy laws). A conference delegate pre-list will be provided by 15 November 2023 and a delegate post-list provided on 1 December 2023.

11. Partners and exhibitors must provide desired guest contacts before 8 September 2023 for review. A guest registration will be provided. For any guest registrations received after this date, AuSAE cannot guarantee ticket availability.

12. The organisers reserve the right to amend the ACE sponsorship and exhibitor program to benefit the partner and/or the event. Every effort will be made to maximise partner benefits as well as delegates' experience.

13. Selection of partners and exhibitors will be based on their ability to meet event requirements and offer innovative solutions. The organisers reserve the right, at their absolute discretion, to deny any offer of partnership.

14. Should an exhibitor or partner or its related entities engage in actions or behaviour likely to adversely impact AuSAE, its members, suppliers or partners then AuSAE may without prejudice terminate this agreement and/or revoke all rights of the partner or exhibitor under this or any other agreement with AuSAE at its discretion and without recompense. This includes offering a service or product similar to that provided by AuSAE, its members, suppliers or partners without the prior written consent of AuSAE.

15. All Budget replacement items are costed at 'at cost' and not 'rack' or 'industry' rates.

16. If the sponsor increases their service prices or product specifications before fulfilling their ACE commitment the partner will honour the level of partnership and/or service delivery with the organiser at the rates agreed upon. i.e. the organiser will not be affected in any negative financial way due to a partner changing service prices or product specifications.

17. After a partnership has been accepted a reduction in partnership is considered a cancellation and will be governed by the organiser's partnership cancellation policy where a fee of 50% in cash of the partnership amount (whether a financial partnership or budget replacement partnership) will apply unless a suitable replacement venue or services can be found.

18. Partner and Exhibitor Registration Transferability: All registrations are transferable in full (i.e. no one-day passes are available) until 72 hours before the 2023 ACE opening. To transfer a registration the person must also be eligible for that registration category.

19. The registrations advised throughout the document for not-for-profit clients are full registrations that include attendance at all ACE sessions, catered breaks, and social functions. AuSAE does not guarantee acceptance of this offer but will take responsibility for making the offer and organising registrations if NFPs accept the offer.
