

House to Home

Partner with service providers for asylum seekers and survivors of domestic violence to provide free furniture and household goods when moving into a new permanent home.

\$1,000 to furnish a home for a family of 2 adults and 2 kids

Legislative Solutions Tax Breaks for Repair of Goods In 2016 Sweden introduced - Reduced GST for repaired goods and - Deduction of repair cost from income tax

Benefits are

- stimulate repair industry
- create local employment
- reduce environmental footprint
- production of better and long lasting products

Legislative Solutions Right to Repair

In 2015 France followed by Germany and Norway introduced legislation for manufacturers:
to label how long spare parts will be available
to offer free repairs for the first 2 years



New York State introduced Right to Repair act making manuals and parts to repair a device available

Legislative Solutions Tax on cheap & replica import

Design and Manufacturing of furniture from reclaimed material is labor intense and expensive

Benefits are

- stimulates local industry
- creates local employment
- reduce environmental footprint
- production of better and long lasting products



Legislative Solutions Remove red tape

ACCC guide to infant second hand products

"Product bans and mandatory standards don't apply when you buy products from private people who are not in business."

Councils offer free child restraint safety checks


