

ASBD provides educational activities and networking opportunities for all medical practitioners and allied health personnel with an interest in breast disease.

Since 1998, the Society has held biennial Scientific Meetings and collaborated on a number of occasions with other organisations to co-host educational events, including the 2nd Australasian Breast Congress in 2016 with BreastSurgANZ, the joint Melbourne International Breast Congress in 2018 with BreastSurgANZ and the Controversies in Breast Cancer group, the Australasian International Breast Cancer Congress in October 2022 and the Leura Meeting in 2024. The ASBD 12th Scientific Meeting was held in 2019 but due to COVID there was no Scientific Meeting in 2021. The 13th Scientific Meeting was held from 14-16 September 2023 at the Adelaide Convention Centre. In 2024 ASBD is one of the three Societies organising the Leura International Breast Cancer Conference.

The society aims to:




ASBD 12th Scientific Meeting 2019

2022 Brisbane - Australasian International Breast Congress (AIBC)


There were 911 registrants at the tri-badged meeting held in Brisbane in October 2022 with surgeons and nurses being our two largest delegate groups.
