The Honourable Justice Rachel Pepper

Land and Environment Court of New South Wales

Justice Rachel Pepper was appointed as a Judge of the Land and Environment Court of NSW in May 2009.

She is also an Adjunct Professor at the University of Sydney's Law School and a

Fellow of the Australian Academy of Law.

Justice Pepper is a member of the Ngara Yura Committee of the Judicial Commission of New South Wales and a member of the AIJA Indigenous Justice Committee. She is on the National Executive Committee of the Australian Institute of Administrative Law. She is a New South Wales representative on the Executive Committee of the Australian Association of Women Judges. She is also a board member of Twenty10.

During 2017 and 2018 her Honour chaired the Scientific Inquiry into Hydraulic Fracturing of Onshore Unconventional Gas Reservoirs and Associated Activities in the Northern Territory.

She is the author of numerous articles and book chapters published nationally and internationally.
