#### About Aislinn McIntyre

Aislinn McIntyre is the Manager of Regulatory Services at the Law Society Northern Territory (Society) having commenced in the role in 2017. She is responsible for managing compliance with the Society's regulatory functions under the Legal Profession Act 2006 including complaints, trust accounts, licensing, admission to the legal profession, professional indemnity insurance and continuing professional development. Aislinn appears as solicitor on the record for many of the matters that the Society has before the Supreme Court of the Northern Territory and the Legal Practitioners Disciplinary Tribunal. The role also includes acting as in house-counsel to advise the Council of the Society on regulatory issues and also providing ethical and regulatory guidance to the Society's members and the public. She is supported by and manages the regulatory team including the Senior Regulatory Solicitor, the Senior Complaints Investigator and the Licensing Officer.

Aislinn has a background in private practice, having worked in the civil litigation practice of a large commercial law firm in Sydney and also in Darwin for 9 years prior to commencing with the Society. She worked predominantly for public sector clients and insurers on large scale litigations and regulatory matters. Since 2018, Aislinn has also been a community member and decision maker on one of the Northern Territory Boards for the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency.
