



The scale of general practice

- 5,600 members working across 1,000 practices.
- Specialist general practitioners are the first point of contact for the majority of community healthcare concerns.
- Specialise in uncertainly, and undifferentiated medical, and mental health issues.
- In 2020, there were 20,500,000 contacts with general practice.
- Main concern is the impact of Long-COVID.



Long-COVID and general practice

Important that care is targeted to those with Long-COVID, as opposed to those who are anxious, or attributing symptoms to it: the 'grey' of general practice

Urgent that place of serology is clarified especially for those who have not tested positive to RAT or PCR.

- We need clear, consistent guidance on diagnosing and treating Long-COVID: most contact will happen at GP clinics.
- An increase of consultations on Long-COVID will add pressure to an already stretched and fatigued workforce.
