 - Digital Tools

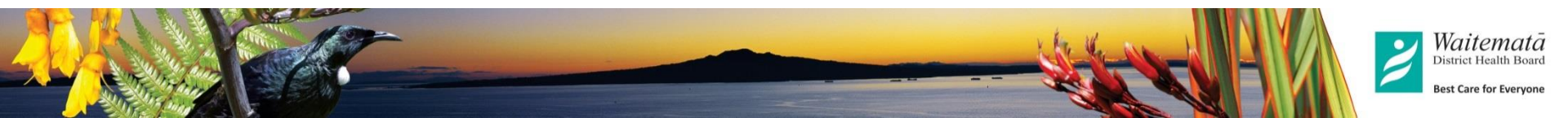
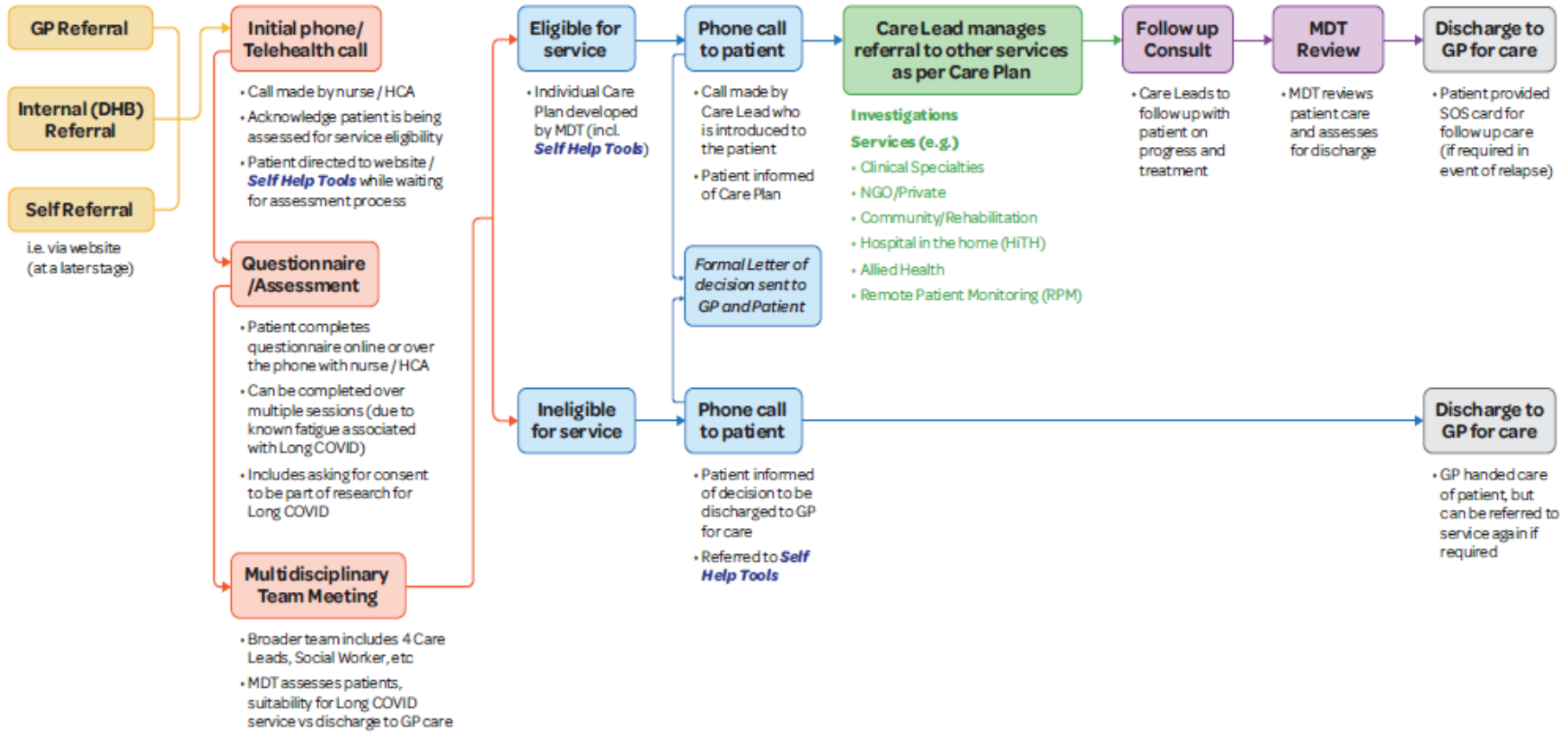


Opportunities
