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Background

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health is an urgent priority. As primary healthcare specialists, GPs are at the forefront of providing high quality, comprehensive healthcare in both mainstream practices and Aboriginal and Community Controlled Health Services.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people experience complex health issues and navigating our health system can be complicated.
