Abstracts are now invited for oral and poster presentation at the RANZCOG 2019 Queensland/New South Wales/Provincial Fellows Regional Scientific Meeting, to be held in Gold Coast, Queensland.

Fellows, trainees, Diplomates, prevocational doctors and medical students are eligible to submit an abstract for consideration. Oral presentations will be selected based on the quality of the research.

Abstracts are welcomed on any topic relevant to women's health. The deadline for abstract submission is **FRIDAY 15 FEBRUARY 2019**. Abstracts should be submitted by the presenting author. Only one author per abstract can be nominated the 'presenting author'. Please note that all presenters (oral and poster) must register for the meeting and pay the appropriate registration fee. It will be assumed any presenter not registered by **Friday 29 March 2019** has withdrawn their abstract from the program.

Oral presentations will take place during sessions on **Saturday 8 June 2019**. Hard copy posters will be displayed on boards in the designated poster exhibition area during the scientific meeting proceedings on **Saturday 8 and Sunday 9 June 2019**.

Awards will be made at the Conference Dinner on Saturday 8 June 2019. Authors wishing to submit an abstract are expected to be registered to attend the Meeting.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Four prizes will be awarded:

- The Crown Street Medal is awarded for the best presentation at this Meeting by a Queensland or New South Wales Registrar holding an accredited RANZCOG Training Program position. Original research or case studies will be suitable.
- The Christopher Kohlenberg Memorial Medal is awarded for the best presentation at this meeting of original research (either clinical or basic science) by a Queensland or New South Wales Registrar holding an accredited RANZCOG Training Program position, or a Fellow of the RANZCOG resident in Queensland or NSW of less than 5 years standing as at 8 June 2019.
- The RANZCOG Queensland Regional Committee Medal will be awarded to the best oral presentation by a doctor resident in Queensland, New South Wales, or the Australian Capital Territory and who is not a trainee or Fellow of the RANZCOG at this meeting. Original research or case studies will be suitable.
- Best Poster Presentation is open to all accepted submissions.

Guidelines:

•

- Abstracts must be submitted electronically, and be accompanied by the abstract submission document (Maximum number of words is 250)
- Abstracts should contain a brief title, clearly identifying the subject of the paper, the author and hospital
- The title of the Abstract should be set flush left of page, using sentence case ie initial capital letter, followed by lower case.
- List details of the author's name (surname followed by initial of first name with a comma separating each author.
- The body of the Abstract should contain:
 - * a sentence stating the purpose of the study
 - * a brief description of the methods
 - * a summary of results
- Original research or case reports will be suitable
- Presentations will be limited to ten minutes, including 2 minutes allowed for questions. These times will be rigidly adhered to.
- Presentations are limited to 15 PowerPoint slides
- Talks should be rehearsed prior to the day of presentation
- Delegates must register by the early bird deadline of **29 March 2019** or it assumed the abstract has been withdrawn
