





Quality Improvement

Practice Assist provides general practices with information, tools and resources to enable the continuous quality improvement within general practice. You can access the <u>QI Toolkit</u> on the Practice Assist website.



QI is a process of regularly reviewing and refining your practice's systems, structures and clinical care to improve patient outcomes and practice efficiency, underpinned by the *Quintuple Aim* of Healthcare.




Our QI Coaches can work with your practice on your Quality Improvement journey.

Digital health is an umbrella term referring to a range of technologies that can be used to safely treat patients and securely collect and share a person's health information, including mobile health and applications, electronic health records, telehealth and telemedicine.

Our Digital Health Team have put together the <u>Digital Health Toolkit</u> to assist general practices with the set up and use of Digital Health Tools.

What is HealthPathways?

A password-protected online clinical support tool developed by GPs that summarises locally relevant and evidence-informed assessment, management, and referral advice on key patient issues.

What are some of the benefits?

- Patients access the right treatment, in the right place, at the right time.
- The needs of rural and remote patients are always considered in the development and review of clinical pathways and referral pages.
- Each pathway is developed in collaboration with local subject matter experts.
- Promotes clinical autonomy and patient choice.
- New pathway developments and existing pathway reviews are planned annually, considering the needs of general practice.

660 pathways available covering a range of conditions, symptoms, procedures and services:

- <u>Abnormal Liver Function Tests</u>
- <u>COVID-19 Assessment and</u>
 <u>Management</u>

- Support commissioning of one-to-one services or population level supports to improve mental health outcomes




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
