# Young Investigator Award

#### Context:

The Young Investigator Award aims to stimulate interest in research training by rewarding outstanding examples of excellence amongst those involved in research training in the early stages of their career. The session focused on 4 of the eight shortlisted presentations.

### Summary:

Dr Saikiran Kakarla, from Sree Chitra Tirunal Insitute in India, opened up the session by presenting a prospective study evaluating markers of atrial cardiopathy and concluded that, in additional to traditional vascular risk factors, left atrial volume index (LAVI) was associated with stroke recurrence.

Dr Surachat Jaroonpipatkul, from Rajavithi Hospital Rangsit University Thailand, presented his study titled "High sensitivity C reactive protein and recurrence after catheter ablation for atrial fibrillation: a meta-analysis and systemic review. He concluded that High sensitivity C reactive protein levels post ablation correlated with AF recurrence after catheter ablation.

Dr Yike Zhang, from the First Affiliated Hospital of Nanjing Medical University, presented "Patients-specific human induced pluripotent stem cell-derived atrial cardiomyocytes demonstrate electric remodelling in LMNA-related atrial fibrillation. He concluded that LMNA mutation is associated with increased risk of atrial fibrillation.

Dr David Chieng, from Alfred Hospital, Melbourne, presented his study titled" Catheter ablation in persistent atrial fibrillation, a randomized trial of posterior wall isolation". He concluded that there is a need to perform further studies to evaluate patient groups who will benefit from posterior wall isolation approach.
