Townsville Region

From the Great Barrier Reef and its tropical islands, to the lush rainforests and World Heritage-listed national parks, the once quiet coastal town has merged into a modern metropolis. Learn from those protecting our earth and fill your days exploring by land or sea.

Climate: The Townsville region experiences two distinct seasons, the 'Green' January through to April, and the 'Dry' May through to December. Summer temperatures range from 31°C (88F) during the day and average at 20°C (68F) at night. Winter temperatures are still quite warm with an average of 25°C (77F) during the day and 13°C (56F) in the evening.

15:00 Arrive Townsville and transfer to accommodation.

It is the perfect backdrop of bright colours and plentiful marine life, providing the perfect balance between both man-made and nature's art. MOUA highlights reef conservation, restoration, and education on a global scale. Discover how the Great Barrier Reef is managed and what work is being done to protect it. The team will take you through ways you can help protect the reef and its creatures for future generations to come. Snorkelling and Scuba Dive is included.

16.30 Arrive back at Townsville Breakwater Marina and disembark. Head back to the hotel to freshen up before the

evening activities.
