<p>Famil Summary</p>	<p>Embarking on a thrilling adventure by helicopter from Melbourne to Wildlife Wonders, a sanctuary for Australian animals which supports the ongoing conservation of native wildlife. Marvel at iconic landmarks along the Great Ocean Road, tracing the vibrant coastline before landing at the coastal village of Apollo Bay. Get up close and have an encounter with Australian creatures in their natural habitat, from kangaroos to koalas, deepening your understanding of the country's unique fauna. The return flight will provide a panorama of landscapes transitioning from wilderness to urban sprawl.</p>

<p>Itinerary 11:30am – 4:30pm</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Depart Melbourne by helicopter taking in the coastline views along the Great Ocean Road – flight time 50-minutes • Land at Apollo Bay Airport on the Great Ocean Road and transfer via road to Wildlife Wonders • Enjoy a 75-minute nature tour encountering beautiful Australian animals living freely, as they would be in the wild. It's almost certain you will see koalas, but you might also be lucky enough to spot a potoroo, bandicoot and many other amazing Australian animals that call Wildlife Wonders home. • Enjoy lunch at Wildlife Wonders • Return via helicopter to Melbourne taking in the stunning views along the Great Ocean Road.
