



What is a whitelist email?

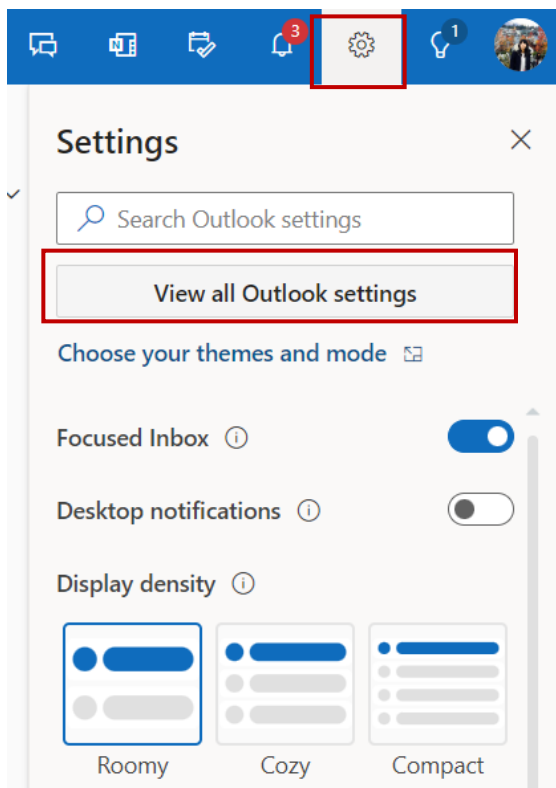
A whitelist an email address is to approve and allow to get all the email messages from the certain email address.



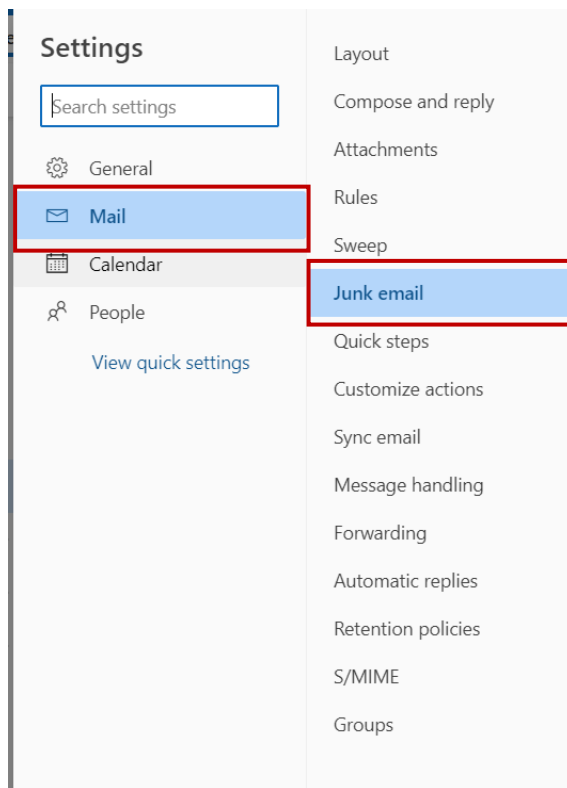


Whitelist in Outlook

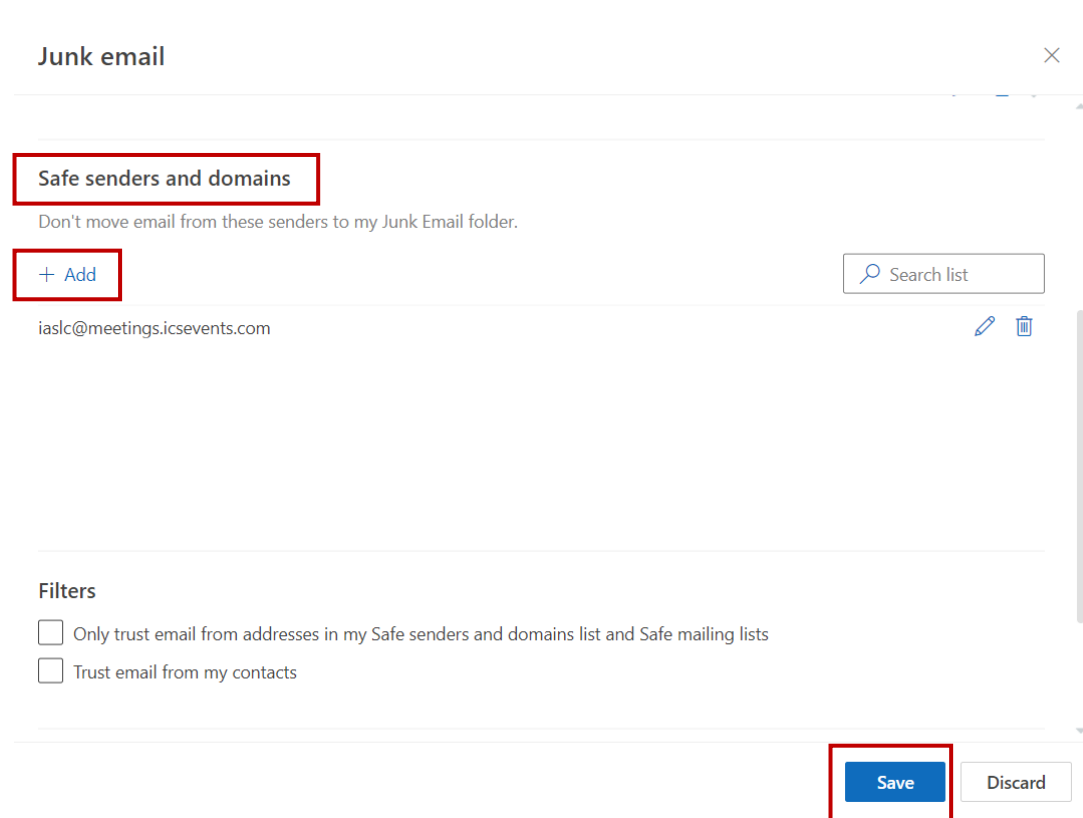
1. Click on “Gear” icon and choose “View all Outlook setting”



2. Click on “Mail” tab, and choose “Junk email” from the submenu



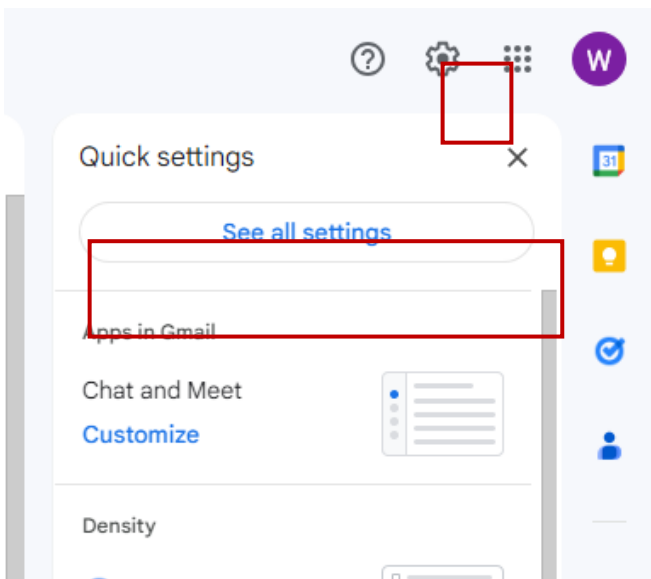
3. Scroll down to “Safe senders and domains” section, click on “Add”. Enter the iaslc@meetings.icsevents.com and don't forget to “save it”.





Whitelist in Gmail

1. Click on “Gear” icon and choose “See all setting”



2. Choose “Filters and Blocked Addresses” from the top navigation bar, and click on “Create a new Filter”

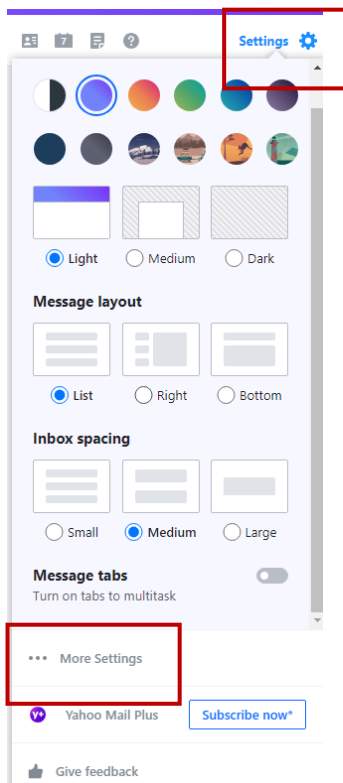

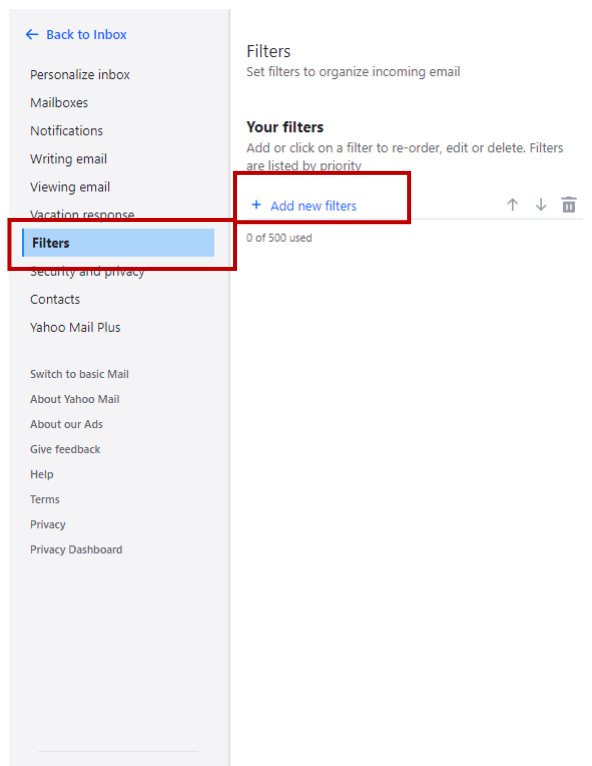


Whitelist in Yahoo
