Point of Care Cardiac Ultrasound

This course reviews the concepts of ultrasound image generation, the function of ultrasound machines and imaging relevant to perioperative practice including focused cardiac ultrasound (FOCUS) with most common views, abdominal ultrasound including intra-peritoneal fluid, bladder volume, IVC assessment and thoracic ultrasound assessing for lung pathology, pneumothorax, pleural effusions, and diaphragm motion.

High fidelity simulation, live simulated patients and case discussions with ultrasound imaging serve as the course core. Substantial pre-reading is required. A pre-test and post-test will also be issued.


