Minoru Nakamura is a civil servant at the Ministry of Finance of the Japanese Government. He began his current post, Deputy Commissioner for International Affairs at the National Tax Agency, in August 2022.

He joined Ministry of Finance in April 1989 and has since been working on various economic policy issues such as tax policy, fiscal policy and management of public assets. He worked as Deputy Director at the International Tax Policy Division, Tax Bureau at the turn of the century, working mainly on the OECD project of the Harmful Tax Competition.

He served as Executive Staff to the Deputy Cabinet Secretary from 2004 to 2006 under the Koizumi Administration and as Personal Secretary to the Minister of Finance in 2012 under the Noda Administration. He also worked at the Embassy of Japan in the UK as Minister for Financial Affairs for three years until last summer.

Minoru studied international relations at Woodrow Wilson School of Public and International Affairs, Princeton University, and majored in law at the University of Tokyo.
