



Mr. **Tao Zhang** has been the Chief Representative of the BIS Office of Asia and the Pacific since September 2022.

Prior to this, he was Chairman of the Supervisory Board at the People's Insurance Company (Group) of China Limited. He also served as Deputy Managing Director of the International Monetary Fund (IMF) in Washington, DC during 2016-2021 and as Deputy Governor of the People's Bank of China (2016). At the IMF, Mr. Zhang oversaw the Fund's engagement with over 100 members and had a wide portfolio, including financial stability policies, fintech and digital currencies, climate change, sustainable growth, and engagement with other international and regional organizations. Mr. Zhang also held senior positions with the People's Bank of China, China's central bank. Earlier in his career, he had worked as an economist at the World Bank and the Asian Development Bank.
