He has been involved in the first-ever MTDS and DSA elaboration process for Georgia. In addition, he has been leading the domestic market development in Georgia, including the establishment of the Primary Dealership system, the issuance of benchmark bonds, the introduction of buy-back operations, and the development of investor relations.

In addition to his Georgian experience, he, as a short-term international expert, has been intensively participating in WB and IMF missions related to debt management, supporting countries in capacity building and in the elaboration of Medium-Term Debt Management strategies.

In parallel with debt management-related activities, Mr. Irakli Katcharava is an Associate Professor at Ilia State University in Georgia and delivers lectures in economics and statistics.

He holds an MA degree in Economics from the International School of Economics at Tbilisi State University (ISET).
