Michael Keen is Ushioda Fellow in Tokyo College, University of Tokyo, having previously been Deputy Director of the Fiscal Affairs Department at the International Monetary Fund, where he played a leading role in shaping and delivering the IMF's advice on tax matters. His academic papers have appeared in leading journals, and he is co-author of books on *The Modern VAT* and *Taxing Profits in a Global Economy*. His most recent book, [*Rebellion, Rascals and Revenues*](#) (with Joel Slemrod), aims to use history and humor to convey basic tax principles to a wider audience.

Michael was President of the International Institute of Public Finance from 2003 to 2006, awarded the CESifo Musgrave Prize in 2010, and in 2018 received from the National Tax Association of the United States its most prestigious award, the Daniel M. Holland Medal for distinguished lifetime contributions to the study and practice of public finance.
