*For Online Moderators:

SETTING UP FOR YOUR SESSION (Online)

- 1. **Lighting**. Be sure that your face is well-lit for the session. Try sitting facing a window for natural lighting. Avoid having light sources behind you that may darken or obscure your face. Also avoid strong light sources from above or the side that might cast a shadow on your face.
- **2. Webcam**. Bring your laptop webcam up to eye level so that you're not looking down on participants during the session. You can do this, for example, by placing your laptop on a stack of books.
- **3. Headphones**. Keep headphones nearby and ready. These will be useful if you find that there is an echo, people have trouble hearing you, or there are other audio problems.
- **4. Background**. If possible, have a plain or simple background behind you so viewers can focus on you rather than your surroundings.
- **5. Internet**. If possible, have a backup internet connection ready in case you run into connectivity problems. For example, you might have your phone's hotspot ready to use during the session.
- **6. Notifications.** Silence your e-email, etc notifications on your laptop and phone to avoid distractions while you present.



Discussants

Role of discussants

- Read through available materials of assigned presenter
- Take maximum of 5 minutes to comment or raise questions to a presenter in the group
- Using a powerpoint presentation is not encouraged

Generic discussant assignments

- Panel discussants. The next presenter after you will serve as your paper's discussant. He or she may comment/raise questions to another presenter in the group, and open the floor for discussion;
- Invited discussants. In the event that some presenters would like to invite an external/in-person discussant, kindly let us know.
