Prior to joining IOM, Sarah was the Undersecretary (Vice-Minister) for Migrant Workers' Affairs of the Department of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of the Philippines. She managed the protection of the rights and promotion of the welfare of over 10 million overseas Filipinos through 94 diplomatic posts. Her work included the repatriation of hundreds of thousands of distressed nationals who were caught in wars, civil or political unrests, natural disasters, victims of abuse or maltreatment, and those who were stranded due to economic hardships and most recently, due to the pandemic. She was the Philippines' Chief Negotiator for the Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration and executed the Philippine kafala reform and fair and ethical recruitment campaigns in the Middle East.
