Joachim von Amsberg is the Special Advisor to the President of AIIB. From 2016 to 2021, he was AIIB Vice-President, Policy and Strategy and drove the strategic direction for the Bank, including its sectoral and country priorities, its investment strategy and programming, its economic analysis and research, and its operating budget. He oversaw the Bank's environmental and social policies, other operational policies, and their implementation. Prior joining to AIIB, he served in a number of progressively senior roles at the World Bank where his last position was Vice-President, Development Finance with responsibility for the replenishment and stewardship of the International Development Association (IDA), the World Bank's fund for the poorest, and for trust fund and partnership operations. Dr. von Amsberg holds a Ph.D. in Economic Policy Analysis and an M.B.A. from the University of British Columbia. He also holds a M.Sc. in Industrial Engineering from the Technical University of Berlin.
