Stefan Rau is Senior Urban Development Specialist in the Urban and Social Sectors Division, in the East Asia Department of the Asian Development Bank (ADB). Stefan prepares and implements integrated economic and urban development projects, promoting socially inclusive and environmentally sound livable cities. He supports policy and institutional capacity development for national urbanization strategy, city cluster coordination, urban-rural integration, climate change adaptation and sponge cities, circular economy zero waste cities, open space planning and ecosystem protection, focusing on the People's Republic of China. Recent work includes the Jilin Yanji Low-Carbon Climate-Resilient Healthy City Project integrating and piloting health impact assessment and healthy and age-friendly city action and management planning (HIA and HACAMP) to systematically bring out health benefits for the emerging four-generation urban society.

Stefan is currently preparing a roadmap for circular economy as one of five roadmaps for the PRC to guide implementation of the newly approved country partnership strategy for the PRC and he is leading a TA on Circular Economy Zero Waste Cities in the PRC.
