**Masato Nakane** serves as the Principal Regional Cooperation Specialist within the Regional Cooperation and Integration Unit (SARC) of the South Asia Department at the Asian Development Bank (ADB). His primary focus is on fostering regional cooperation in South Asia, especially through the South Asia Subregional Economic Cooperation Program (SASEC).

From September 2021 to September 2023, Masato took a special leave from the ADB to contribute to the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank, enhancing his experience in regional development.

Prior to his leave, he worked with SARC from 2015 to 2021, where he played a key role in trade and transport facilitation initiatives for SASEC countries and oversaw operations in the Maldives.

Before joining the ADB, Masato's career included important roles at the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, the International Monetary Fund, and the Japan International Cooperation Agency, where he developed expertise in international development and economic policy.
