Constitutional Mandates

Demography (21 Million PwDs & 1 Billion Elderly)

Fundamental Rights

- ARTICLE 15(1) Enjoins the government "not to discriminate against any citizen of India
- ARTICLE 39 "The state shall, in particular, direct its policy toward securing: That every citizen, equally, have the right to an adequate means to livelihood.

Directive Principles of State Policy

 ARTICLE 41: Provides for effective provisions for securing the right to work, to education, and public assistance in cases of unemployment, old age, sickness, and disablement,

UN Resolutions

- UNCRPD 2006 (India is the first signatory)
- Incheon Strategy make the right real
- SDGs



Legislative Framework

RPWD Act-2016

- The act outlines provisions for Social security and social safeguards including reservation in public employment, Financial Assistance in crisis, penalties for discrimination etc.
- The act also outlines provisions for ensuing accessibility and access to ATs for PwDs,
- The National Trust for Welfare of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disability Act, 1999
 - Provides for Health Insurance for Autism Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities
 - Provides for Assistive Devices & Financial assistance for health and education,

The Rehabilitation Council of India Act-1992

Regulate the special education and provides for care services training



Social Protection Programs

Direct Cash Transfers

- Social Assistance Programs (Pension, Food Subsidies)
- Scholarships and Fellowships (Pre & Post Metric, NFs. NOS)
- Subsidized Credit facilities (Interest Free Loans, Subsidies, etc.)
- Marriage allowances (Men and Women PwDs marrying to normal Person)

Kind based assistance

- Distribution of ATs (ADIP, AVVYA, SSA, NBEP, NHIP etc.)
- Travel Concessions (Air, Railways, Bus etc.)
- Tax rebates (GST etc.)
- Relaxations and concessions in age, qualifications for admission and Public Employment
- Free Coaching & Skill & Entrepreneurship Trainings

Other Initiatives

- Accessible India Campaign
- Promotion of Skill and Entrepreneurship among PwDs
- Grants for purchase of Assistive Devices
