

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Abstract submissions are invited for both oral and poster presentations for the **World Congress of Echocardiography** to be held in Adelaide, Australia from 6 – 8 May 2022.

The meeting aims to present state of the art research from 3 specific streams – basic to advanced echocardiography, structural heart disease and point of care ultrasound.

Please note, if you are unable to attend the Conference in-person, you are still invited to submit your abstract as there will be opportunities to present virtually if accepted.

Submission information:

Authors do not need to be ISCU members to participate.

All expenses (e.g., submission, conference registration, airfare, lodging, etc.) associated with the submission and presentation of an abstract are the responsibility of the presenter.

Submission of an abstract constitutes a commitment by the author(s) to register and present if accepted.

Abstract Submission Details:

Please proofread the final document thoroughly before submitting it to the Congress.

All papers need to be submitted via the online abstract submission portal.

Once an account has been created, you will be able to make submissions via the Upload Submission area of the site.



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Here you will be asked to supply the following:

- Abstract title (max 50 words)
- Relevant stream for abstract presentation
- Preferred presentation type (oral or poster)
- Authors and affiliations
- Presenting author biography (max 300 words)
- Upload submission document

Please note that you will not be able to make edits to your submission once it has been submitted. It is best to save as a DRAFT until you are ready to submit.

Selection Criteria Submissions will be reviewed on the following criteria:

- Relevance to conference themes
- Originality & interest
- Structure & clarity
- Scientific validity
- Potential significance

Notification

The WCE2022 Program Sub-Committee will notify authors of acceptance by 1 February 2021 at the latest. All presenters will be required to register for the conference by 28 February 2021 to be included in the Conference program. Accepted presenters who fail to register by the deadline will be withdrawn from the Conference proceedings. The lodgement of a submission does not indicate automatic inclusion in the Conference program. Receipt and acceptance will be acknowledged to the person submitting. Further communication will be with the submitting author only unless otherwise directed.

Abstract Preparation Guidelines:

Author Name(s)

There is no limit to the number of abstracts an author may submit. If an abstract is accepted, the presenter must be one of the co-authors listed. Do not list authors by initials only.

Data

Authors may not submit the same research. Abstracts that appear to be replicate versions of a single study will be rejected. Abstracts containing identical or nearly identical data submitted from the same institution and/or individuals will be rejected.

Format:

Original science:

Content should be structured into the following sections, Background, Methods, Results and Conclusions

Clinical cases:



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Content should be structured into the following sections, Clinical Presentation, Imaging Findings, Summary/Discussion Points

Content

Character limit – Abstracts are limited to 2,000 characters. This includes the text but not the title or authors.

Tables/Graphics – The use of tables and graphics are encouraged if they are relevant to the research submitted. Each abstract may include up to 1 graphic or table.

Do not include:

References, key words, credits, or grant support in your submission.

Names or personal information of any patient participating in the study or trial. If you do, the abstract will not be considered for presentation.

Authors or institutions in the title.
