SHORT COURSE DESCRIPTION

In understanding of the basic geochemical concepts of element distribution, geochemical processes and relationships at various scales will be combined with sampling theory and practices to provide a model-based geochemical exploration workshop. Sampling strategies, sample types, and key analytical methodologies will be discussed, leading into multi-element strategies for data interpretation and target selection. The workshop will utilise a variety of mineralisation styles demonstrate how simple chemical principles can be applied to enhance discovery through the application of chemistry in mineral exploration. There will be a mixture of presentations and short practical exercises.

Regolith processes, geochemical mapping and the problem of cover

David Cohen has over 35 years research experience in exploration and environmental geochemistry with projects based in Australia, Cyprus, Asia, the Middle East and North America. He has published over 90 papers, book chapters and major government reports, and is an associate editor of the Journal of Geochemical Exploration. He is currently the President of the Australian Geoscience Council and is a former head of the School of Biological, Earth and Environmental Sciences at UNSW, and a former President of the Association of Applied Geochemists. He is on the scientific advisory board of the MinEx CRC. He was the 2013 AusIMM visiting lecturer to New Zealand, the 2018 AAG Silver Medallist and is a Fellow of the Royal Society of NSW.

The secondary environment, analytical methods and QAQC

Dennis Arne has 40 years' experience in geology and applied geochemistry globally. He has overseen regional geochemical exploration programs in the Yukon, British Columbia, Nunavut and northern Quebec in Canada, the USA, eastern Australia, Suriname, Sudan and Laos. He was Managing Director and Principal Consultant - Geochemistry of CSA Global Canada until late 2017, General Manager and Principal Consultant - Geochemistry for Revelation Geoscience (purchased by CSA Global in 2012). Principal Consulting Geochemist with ioGlobal (now Reflex Geochemistry) and formerly Senior Geochemist with Geoscience Victoria (now Geological Survey of Victoria, Australia). Dennis is currently director and principal consulting geochemist at Telemark Geosciences and was until recently Director of Exploration for E79 Resources. He is a Fellow and former President of the Association of Applied Geochemists, is a Member and a Registered Professional Geoscientist (Geochemistry) of the Australian Institute of Geoscientists (#10064), and a registered Professional Geoscientist in British Columbia, Canada (#34686).
