1.0 Special Resolution 1 – AMENDMENT TO MODEL RULE 2.

The following is presented at the Annual General Meeting to consider and if thought fit to pass, special resolution of the Members that the Model Rules of the Association be amended by:

Vote - For or Against - Amend Model Rule 18(1) c) as detailed:

c) 6 representatives to be elected from the ranks of Full Members.

For reference - this is the current Model Rule

18. Membership of management committee

- (1) The members of the Executive Committee shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting of the incorporated association in accordance with its rules. Within three months of the association's annual general meeting the executive committee will determine the strategic priorities for its term of office. The Executive Committee shall comprise:
- a) President The role of President should be filled by an experienced and recognised nursing leader in Queensland with the demonstrated ability to advocate and represent nursing at a strategic level to achieve the goals of the Association and for the profession
- b) Vice-President
- c) 10 representatives to be elected from the ranks of Full Members.

Background – The number of representatives on the committee has been discussed by the executive committee over the past few years. It is hoped by keeping the Executive Committee to a total of 8 Members (including the President & Vice President) that it will be more likely to reach quorum.
