Shotover Jetboat Ride

You can't beat the thrill of a Shotover Jet experience. It's an adrenaline rush you'll never forget! From the moment the accelerator hits the floor, your adrenaline hits the roof as you power through the Shotover River and deep into the Shotover River canyons! It's an amazing ride, as the Shotover Canyon walls tower over you, and your driver skilfully whips the boat past rocky outcrops, and skims around crags and boulders.

Shotover Jet is located 7kms from downtown Queenstown and complimentary shuttle bus transfers to/from the Queenstown Information Centre are included in the ticket price.

Outback New Zealand – Nomad Safaris – The Original 4WD Adventure, Skippers Canyon

Nomad Safaris Skippers Canyon adventure is a half-day heritage tour that follows the rugged and once treacherous Skippers Road. Real Journeys – Milford Sound Coach – Nature Cruise (Coach ex Queenstown)
