International Guest Presenter

Sanj Kakar, MD is Professor of Orthopaedics, past Vice Chair of the Clinical Practice Committee within the Department of Orthopaedic Surgery, Associate Medical Director for the Quality Academy and serves as the Medical Director for the Digital Platform within Continuous Professional Development at Mayo Clinic, Rochester, Minnesota and a graduate of St. Bartholomew's and The Royal London School of Medicine and Dentistry, he received his surgical



training at University College London, The Royal National Orthopaedic Hospital and The Royal Free, before completing his Orthopaedic Residency at Boston University, Boston. He completed his Hand Surgery fellowship at Mayo Clinic andis Board Certified by the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery and the American Society for Surgery of the Hand.

Dr. Kakar is a specialist in disorders of the hand and wrist, in particular, arthroscopy, complex wrist reconstruction, trauma and sports injuries. He is a surgeon scientist and is Principal Investigator studying the role of four-dimensional CT scanning on wrist kinematics. Dr Kakar received the Marshall Urist Young Investigator award from the Association of Bone and Joint Surgeons, and has authored over 220 peer reviewed scientific papers, 45 book chapters and co-editor of four orthopaedic textbooks in the Hand and Wrist. He currently serves as the Editor of Hand.e, the Digital Education Platform of the American Society for Surgery of The Hand and is the President of the Minnesota Orthopaedic Society.



Dr. Jeremy Loveridge is an internationally trained Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon and specialist in hand, wrist and elbow surgery, including microsurgery. Working with, and being mentored by nternationall respectd hand, wrist and elbow surgeons, Dr. Loveridge was awarded his Fellowship in Trauma and Orthopaedic Surgery from the Royal Collage of Surgeons of England in 2010. He came to Australia in 2011 to undertake further sub-specialty training at

Perth Orthopaedic and Sports Medicine Centre and subsequently completing a year's Fellowship in Hand and Upper Limb Surgery, including Microsurgery, at the prestigious Brisbane Hand and Upper Limb Research Institute. Dr. Loveridge was invited to Cairns to set up a specialist hand clinic and had initially planned to return to the UK, but decided to stay in Cairns where he currently runs the hand uni and actively trains junior surgeons along with teaching medical students and the Cairns Hospital.

Abstract Submissions

(ABSTRACTS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED ELECTRONICALLY) Submission as follows via the Taylored Images website: www.tayloredimages.com.au

- (a) Follow the links to 2022 QLD Hand; click on "Submit Abstract" and follow the prompts
- **(b)** It is essential all photographs and diagrams are embedded within the document, prior to uploading the abstract
- (c) On submission, you will be prompted to create an account which will allow you to view & edit your abstract/s after initial submission until 1700 Friday 16 September 2022.

Scientific papers are invited for oral presentations. Authors should submit abstracts written in English to Taylored Images no later than **1700 (EST) on Friday 16 September 2022.** Papers received after this date will not be accepted for inclusion in this year's program.

All abstracts submitted are subject to review by the Scientific Program Committee. Once abstracts have been accepted for presentation, no changes will be accepted to their content.

Disclaimer

All speakers/presenters are to disclose any financial involvement or assistance they have received for their paper.

The abstract should provide sufficient information to allow the reader to fully assess the aims, methods, results and implications of the work undertaken. The abstract should include the following sections:

- Introduction the purpose of the study and a brief overview of relevant literature/current state of research in the field
- Methods a short explanation of data collection and processing
- Results presented in the form of text, graphics or tables
- Discussion major findings and conclusions from the work including implications for further research

It is important that methods and results are clearly defined in the abstract; therefore, general statements such as "results will be presented" are not acceptable.

Lavout

- Abstracts must be on 160mm x 245mm rectangular space on A4 page (210mm x 297mm)
- Portrait orientation
- Margins are all to be 2cm
- Text should be single spaced
- Font should be Calibri typeface and 11 point character size

Title and Author

- Each of the below need to be at the top of the abstract, each on a new line:
- The title (upper case)
- The name(s) of the author(s) please omit university degrees and titles
- The name of the presenter to be underlined
- Affiliation(s), city and country please omit street address and postcode
- · Leave two lines before commencing the body of the text

Section Headings and Paragraphs

- The title of each section is to be bold & left justified
- Leave a 6-space indentation at the beginning of each new paragraph. Leave a 1 line space between each paragraph
- Graphs, tables and references may be used throughout the abstract but must remain within the defined one-page limit
