#### **Project Framing**

The end goal is to get an understanding of what the ideal learning environment is coming from very different backgrounds

- Speaking a common language
- Start from what faculty know
- Eliminate all assumptions





#### **High Level Findings...**

#### Survey

- 867 as of 05/28/2019
  - 4 campuses with zero responses
- Distinct difference in responses between experience levels
- Faculty provided feedback from 6 major LMSs (43 "LMSs" total)

Listening Sessions


- Faculty do not know Workplace
