Session Formats

Presentations (45 minutes in length)

Ignite Session (6 minutes 40 seconds in length, multiple presentations within a 45 minute session) Posters

Vendor Presentation (30 minutes in length, in conjunction with a campus participant and for participating vendors only, subject to vendor participation level)

Session Format Descriptions

Presentations

Presentations are 45 minutes in length. Presentations could consist of an academic paper, campus initiative and/or discussion of programs or services offered in reference to the chosen track. Q & A and handouts are strongly encouraged. It is recommended that there are no more than 4 speakers for this format.

Ignite Session

An Ignite Session is 6 minutes and 40 seconds in length. Participants are invited to present a short compilation of 20 slides, each slide lasting only 20 seconds. An ignite presentation is meant to "ignite" or "spark" ideas in others. Get others excited and showcase your campus initiative, best practice, or passion for a new teaching tip, technique or tool. Slides should be timed to rotate automatically. Due to the time constraints of an Ignite Session it is recommended that no more than 1 presenter participate in this session.

Posters

Poster are exhibited for 15 minutes in length. Presenters are available for demonstrations, displays, and/or discussions with conference attendees.

Vendor Presentation

Vendor Track presentations will be 30 minutes in length and will ideally tie into one of the conference themes. Vendors who wish to present MUST submit an abstract of their presentation that includes, or is in conjunction with, an institute of higher learning, who has used the product/service in an innovative manner to improve student success. We invite you to present the innovation, its development, implementation, outcome, and the effectiveness of the product/service in higher education. Vendor sponsorship levels must be paid IN FULL before submitting a proposal. Any proposals submitted prior to confirmation of payment will be rejected.
