Session Format Descriptions

Presentations

Presentations are 30 minutes in length. Presentations could consist of an academic paper, campus initiative and/or discussion of programs or services offered in reference to the chosen track. Q & A and handouts are strongly encouraged. It is recommended that there are no more than 3 speakers for this format.

Lightning Session

A Lightning session is 7 minutes in length within concurrent session. Participants are invited to present a short compilation of slides. The short presentation is meant to “spark” ideas in others. Get others excited and showcase your campus initiative, best practice, or passion for a new teaching tip, technique, or tool. Due to the time constraints of a Lightning Session, it is recommended that there be no more than 1 presenter per submission.

Hands on Demo/Workshop

Hands on Demos/Workshops are 90 minutes in length. Participants who attend these sessions will have the opportunity to actively participate in the instructional strategies being presented. This can be achieved by discussion or a technology tutorial and allows participants to develop their expertise in a specific area.
