Theme: Sustaining the Momentum: Building on what we've learned

The past two years have been a rapid adoption of new educational technologies and practices. During this conference we can reflect on what we have learned and evaluate what future directions we should take.

Tracks:

- 1. **Building an Inclusive Campus -** this track focuses on campus, program, and department initiatives and includes such topics as: creating an anti-racist/inclusive curriculum; addressing equity gaps, diversifying faculty and staff, accessibility, implementing universal design, addressing the digital divide
- Creating an Inclusive Classroom this track focuses on creating a supportive classroom and includes such topics as: pedagogy of care, trauma-informed teaching, implementing universal design concepts in the classroom, open resources, open pedagogies
- 3. **Educational Technologies for Engagement** this track focuses on tools that are used in the classroom and includes such topics as: student engagement tools, student portfolios, maker spaces, virtual learning, artificial intelligence, mixed reality, robotics
- 4. **Pedagogically Speaking** this track focuses on the methods professors use to interact with learners and includes such topics as: engagement, gamification, multidisciplinary approaches, adaptive learning, active learning spaces, blended/hybrid, hyflex, class community
- 5. **Effective Sharing Methods** this track focuses on new and effectives ways to promote and share innovative approaches across the academy and includes such topics as: professional development, sharing among campuses, faculty fellows
